THE EASTBOURNE BOROUGH COUNCIL (TEMPORARY STREET CLOSURE) (NO. 21) ORDER 2024

TOWN POLICE CLAUSES ACT 1847 (AS AMENDED)

Beachy Head Marathon Weekend

Eastbourne Borough Council in exercise of their powers under Section 21 of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847, as amended by Section 28 of the East Sussex Act 1981 and all other enabling powers, and after consultation with, or with the consent of, as may be required by statute, the County Council of East Sussex and the Chief Officer of Police, hereby make the following Order:

- 1. For the purposes of facilitating the holding of Beachy Head Marathon Weekend in Eastbourne, the lengths of roads set out in the Schedule to this Order shall be closed to vehicular traffic between 05:30 and 19:00 on 26 October and 05:30 and 14:30 on 27 October 2024.
- 2. Nothing in this Order shall prevent a Police Officer from suspending for any period the provisions of this Order in respect of any highway closed by virtue of this Order or prohibit any act done at the discretion or with the consent of a Police Officer.
- 3. Should the event be cancelled then the provisions of this Order shall not take effect.
- 4. The making of this Order does not authorise or otherwise make lawful the obstruction of the highway nor shall it be interpreted as giving such authorisation.
- 5. This Order may be cited as "The Eastbourne Borough Council (Temporary Street Closure) (No. 21) Order 2024".
- 6. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament, as if this Order were an Act of Parliament.

SCHEDULE

Details of roads and length of roads in Eastbourne to be affected by the Order

King Edward's Parade	From its junction with Dukes Drive to its junction with Chesterfield Road.
Dukes Drive	From its junction with Cliff Road to its junction with Wellcombe Crescent.
Upper Dukes Drive	Part carriageway closure from its Junction with Beachy Head Road to its Junction with Wellcombe Crescent (access maintained for residents). Access maintained in opposite direction.
Holywell Road	From its junction with Cliff Road to its junction with Dukes Drive (residential access maintained).
